Docks & Moorings Requirements and Regulations

Welcome to another great season at the WLYC! In an effort to reduce the size of our mooring field we are requiring that All Sunfish, Opti and kayaks be on racks. All boats either moored (Town Permit Required) or on racks at WLYC must be easily identifiable in case of damage or mooring failure.

Enclosed you will find the following:

- Sunfish/Opti Rack Registration Form
- Mooring Field Registration Form for all Powerboats, Sunfish & other sailing craft

Moorings: *All moorings must be permanently marked with your name.

- You must inscribe or use waterproof stickers on mooring float.
- NO MAGIC MARKERS OF ANY TYPE.
- Your mooring must be good repair meeting WLYC and Town requirements – **TOWN PERMIT REQUIRED.**
- All moorings will be inspected prior to dropping in mooring field – Town of Barnstable Mooring Permit Required.
- Moorings will be dropped in on Sunday, June 15th between 9 and 11 am.
- Anchor Outboard will be more than happy to help you acquire or repair you mooring.
- All Mooring Registration forms must be received by mail/email by Friday June 13th or dropped off at the club between 8 am and 9am on Sunday, June 15th (“Docks & Moorings Day”).

Rack Space:

- All racks will be assigned and the club will put your name on the rack.
- Rack fees (\$25.⁰⁰ payable to WLYC) must be paid on or before June 15 (“Docks and Moorings Day”).
- You must have your name clearly marked on your boat and any center boards, rudders, sails, masts, etc.
- Last year’s renters have first priority to their old spot.
- Available space is on first come first serve basis.
- Any boat not registered for rack space will be removed.

Per Barnstable Harbor Master there is absolutely no fueling of any kind on the lake including the dock. Town Mooring Permit Required.

WLYC MOORING REQUIREMENTS

- Regulation Mushrooms are the only weighted object that can be used as a mooring.
- There must be an appropriate length of chain connected to the mushroom by a shackle.
- All shackles must be secured with metal or plastic wire ties.
- There must be a swivel somewhere in the line.
- If using a line between the chain and the surface, it must be connected by a thimble.
- Only regulation plastic or foam buoys may be used.
- It is strongly suggested that connected lines that secure the boat to the mooring have a spring-loaded clip.
- Permanent name on buoy (**no magic marker**).
- Mooring must be in good repair.
