Notice of Race  
Sailing Instructions

Time: Report time for this regatta is 9am at Wequaquet Lake Yacht Club

Who: This regatta is open to all four Opti classes. Red, White, Blue, and Green Fleets

Where: Located at Wequaquet Lake Yacht Club. Please Reference the Directions link on the website ([www.wlyc.com](http://www.wlyc.com))

Sailing Instructions:

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the 2009-2012 ISAF Rules, the Racing Rules of Sailing, the Prescriptions of the U.S. Sailing Association, and by these Sailing Instructions

Notices to Competitors: Notices to Competitors will be posted on the Regatta Board in the main hall of the club. Any changes will be posted prior to 0900 hours each day or as announced at the skippers' meeting.

Course: The red, white, and blue fleets will sail a trapezoidal course with the start/finish line in the middle. Green Fleet will sail either a modified triangle, start/finish in the middle, or windward/leeward start/finish in the middle.

Marks: The marks will be orange drop marks.

Starts/Finishes: The Start Line will be between the R/C float Boat and an orange drop mark.

Recalls: The race committee will endeavor to notify each boat recalled by hail. However, it is the responsibility of each sailor to make a proper start. A general recall will be signaled by multiple short blasts immediately following the start signal. If a general recall is used, the next start will be an "around the ends" start if over after 1 minute.

Scoring: The low-point scoring system will apply. Four (4) races are required to constitute a series. If there are SIX OR MORE Races sailed, the worst race of each competitor will be excluded. The Race Committee may stop a race and score an unfinished boat last, if waiting for her to finish would cause a delay. There is NO LIMIT on the total amount of races that will be sailed. We do not plan to start any green fleet race after 2:00PM or any red, white, blue race past 4:00pm.

Capsizing: If the safety of the crew or boat is in jeopardy or if the progress of the regatta is affected, the Race Committee may require a boat to accept assistance and retire from the race.

Protests: The protest flag requirement is waved. However, the protesting boat shall inform the R/C of the intent to protest when she finishes. Written protests are required and shall be filed with the R/C promptly after reaching the clubhouse. Forms will be furnished by the R/C.

Safety: Coast Guard Approved Personal Flotation Devices must be worn at all times.

Prizes: Red, White, and Blue division will receive trophies for their individual classes. Green Fleet division will all receive participation awards.
