

## Wequaquet Lake Yacht Club • 2009 Docks & Moorings Requirements and Regulations

Welcome to another great season at the WLYC! In an effort to reduce the size of our mooring field we are requiring that All Sunfish, Opti and kayaks be on racks. All boats either moored (Town Permit Required) or on racks at WLYC must be easily identifiable in case of damage or mooring failure.

Enclosed you will find the following:

- Mooring Field Registration Form for all Powerboats & other sailing craft
- Sunfish/Opti/Kayak Rack Registration Form

Moorings: \*All moorings must be permanently marked with your name.

- You must inscribe or use waterproof stickers on mooring float.
- NO MAGIC MARKERS OF ANY TYPE
- All moorings will be inspected prior to dropping in mooring field – Town of Barnstable Mooring Permit Required.
- Moorings will be dropped in on Saturday, June 13, between 9 and 11 am.
- Anchor Outboard will be more than happy to help you acquire or repair you mooring.
- All Mooring Registration forms must be received by mail/email by Friday June 12<sup>th</sup> or dropped off at the club between 8 am and 9am on Saturday, June 14<sup>th</sup> (“Docks & Moorings Day”).
- WLYC mooring policy is on registration form

Rack Space:

- All racks will be assigned and the club will put your name on the rack.
- Rack fees (\$25.<sup>00</sup> payable to WLYC) must be paid on or before June 15 (“Docks and Moorings Day”).
- You must have your name clearly marked on your boat and any center boards, rudders, sails, masts, etc.
- Last year’s renters have first priority to their old spot.
- Available space is on first come first serve basis.
- Any boat not registered for rack space will be removed.

Per Barnstable Harbor Master there is absolutely no fueling of any kind on the lake including the dock. Town Mooring Permit Required.

## WLYC Mooring Policy

- All moorings are to be inspected and registered with the Town of Barnstable.
- All moorings must be permanently marked with your name.
- No mooring shall exceed 150 lbs. If your boat requires a heavier mooring, it is too big for WLYC.
- Placement of a mooring is at the discretion of the Commodore or mooring master.
- A copy of your insurance policy or watercraft endorsement on your homeowner's policy along with the WLYC Mooring Registration Form must be received by Docks and Moorings Day.
- Attendance is required at Docks and Moorings Days (in and out). Mooring owners or their representatives need to be there for a mooring to be placed or hauled. Failure to participate will result in loss of WLYC Mooring Field privileges.

No boats are to be left on the beach area, the grounds or tied to the dock, other than for rigging purposes, without the approval of the Sailing Director or the Commodore.

All sails, masts, rudders, oars, etc. must be neatly put away and clearly marked with your name. All boats must be clearly marked with your name.
