- **Please make sure you have fully read the notice of race before coming to the regatta.**
- Registration will be done online, so please make sure you register by downloading the form, filling it out, scanning it and sending it back via email (wlejava@aol.com).
- The regatta this year is capped at 35 boats due to parking lot and staging area size and ability to socially distance.
- To make more room in the parking lot this year, trailers will be brought to a different location for the weekend. It will be in close proximity to the club.
- The skipper's meeting will be held in the parking lot.
- We will head out to sail once the meeting is over and will remain on the water for the day. Lunch will be handed out on the water and will consist of a sandwich, fruit, and granola bar. We will also have water and Gatorade out on the water.
- We ask that all sailors please bring some sort of camp/sporting chair with them. We will have a tent set up in the parking lot for sailors' use.
- After sailing on Saturday, sailors may purchase a drink from the bar through our outdoor service window.
- Sunday morning, sailors will head out on the water for the 10am start and no races will start after 1300 hours.
- Lunch will be served in the parking lot and consist of items from our grill (burgers, hotdog, or chicken sandwich) in a to go box.
- Awards will be done in the parking lot as soon as possible after the racing commences.
