



Wequaquet Lake Yacht Club Docks & Moorings Requirements and Regulations

To reduce the size of our mooring field we are requiring that all Sunfish, Optimist and kayaks be on racks. All boats either moored (Town permit required) or on racks at WLYC must be easily identifiable in case of emergency, damage or mooring failure. Rack forms are available on our website.

Moorings: *All moorings must be permanently marked with your name.

- You must inscribe or use waterproof stickers on mooring float.
- NO MAGIC MARKERS OF ANY TYPE
- All moorings will be inspected prior to dropping in mooring field – Town of Barnstable Mooring Permit Required.
- Moorings will be dropped in on “Docks and Mooring Day.”
- Anchor Outboard in Hyannis will be more than happy to help you acquire or repair you mooring. They deliver and repair onsite.
- All Mooring Registration forms must be received by mail/email the Friday before “Docks & Moorings Day.” Otherwise, bring them in person at 9 a.m. on “Docks & Moorings Day.”
- WLYC mooring policy is written on the registration form below

**Per Barnstable Harbor Master there is absolutely no fueling of any kind on the Lake including the dock.

WLYC Mooring Policy

- All moorings are to be inspected and registered with the Town of Barnstable.
- All moorings must be permanently marked with your name.
- No mooring shall exceed 150 lbs. If your boat requires a heavier mooring, it is too big for WLYC.
- Placement of a mooring is made in partnership with Town of Barnstable Harbor Master and at the discretion of the Commodore or Mooring Master.
- A copy of your insurance policy or watercraft endorsement on your homeowner’s policy, along with the WLYC Mooring Registration Form, must be received by Docks and Moorings Day.
- **Attendance is required at Docks and Moorings Days (in and out). Mooring owners or their representatives need to be there for a mooring to be placed or hauled. Failure to participate will result in loss of WLYC Mooring Field privileges.**
